Worship is not:

- Something done solely by Christians or "spiritual" people
- A style of music
- Something that starts and stops
- Something that is connected to a place or time

Worship is:

Living our life, individually or corporately, as a continuous living sacrifice to the glory of a person or thing.

Romans 11:36-12:1

Glory means weightiness, importance, preeminence, priority, or that which is our greatest treasure, deepest longing, and fountain of hope. You make sacrifices for your glory.

Whatever is #1, that is our "God"

John 1:14 " He is the only one worthy of the position of glory

Jesus was worshipped as the only God by angels before He entered human history as a man " Isaiah 6:1-3, John 12:41

Today and forever Jesus is worshipped in heaven as the only God by both Christians & Angels

Revelation 4:10-11, 5:11-13, 7:11-12, 21:22-23
